## He was Transfigured...

In this Sunday's Gospel we have St Mark's account of the Transfiguration of Jesus on Mt Tabor.

In the previous chapter of the same Gospel Jesus asked his disciples the question; "Who do people say that I am?" St Peter replied: "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God". St Peter got it right but when he was told that the Son of Man will be killed, he protested. It was then

that Jesus scolded St Peter by calling him 'Satan' and told him to get behind Him.

Perhaps the main reason Our Lord revealed the Transfiguration to St Peter, and Sts James and John, was to strengthen them to face the darkness of the cross that was to come. It was a preview of what is to happen: He will triumph. The hour of glory will come, but only after the shadow of the cross.

May the Transfiguration of Jesus strengthens us too in our own carrying of the cross, because beyond the cross, lies the Transfiguration and the glory.

## The Liturgical Season of Lent

In Lent, the ALLELUIA is omitted. For Sunday Masses, when Fr Michael is the celebrant, he (or a cantor when available) will intone "*Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ*", or "*Glory to you, Word of God, Lord Jesus Christ*" instead of the Alleluia. He will also intone the verse in between. Please if you proclaim the readings, DO NOT read out the Acclamation and verse when they are being sung!

(For weekday masses, read the middle verse only)

The sacrifice of Abraham, our father in faith.

This is my Son, the beloved; listen to him.
